19 /16: PRESENT: Chairman Meirion Jones, Cllrs Brian Thomas , Mairwen Rees, Sarah Thomas, Dylan Thomas, David Jones, Lee Strudwick and Haydn Jones

In attendance were County Cllr. Mansel Charles and the clerk Gaynor Davies.

20 /16: CHAIRMANS WELCOME – The chairman welcomed everyone present to the July meeting.

PCSO Roger Anthony attended the meeting and was happy to share that there had been no issues in the area.

21 /16: DECLARATIONS OF PERSONAL INTEREST – County Cllr. Mansel Charles declared an interest in any planning issues that will arise.

22/16 CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC – The LVS had forwarded the bullet points from their recent meeting .A questions was asked regarding the storage of a Western Mail news article featuring the Village of Llanfynydd dated July 2003 . Unfortunately there are no facilities within the Community Council to archive newspaper articles,

24/16: MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- a. 45/16a the Gazebo has been returned to the village, but it has been damaged and needs repairing. Quotation for repair were accepted and Councillors have agreed to meet over the following weeks to prepare a base for the gazebo.

26 / 16 Japanese Knotweed

- a. As no quotations had been received as yet, Councillors agreed that we should consider the spraying being done by a Councillor as the work needs to be completed within a timescale for its maximum benefit.

27/16: HALL PLOT/COMMUNITY GARDEN

- a) Following the agreement of the tender the work will be completed in due course , weather permitting
- b) The Chairman thanked Councillor D Jones for cutting the grass at the plot.

28/16: ROAD MAINTENANCE

- a. 9/16a: Right of Way opposite Meadow View – To be reviewed.
- b. 9/16b: Pot holes at Bryn yr Eglwys – To be reviewed.
- c. 9/16c: North Lodge Pant Glas Hall – the initial response from CCC is that the land owner is responsible , however Councillors are unhappy with the response as they feel that the flooding is as a direct result of road works completed by CCC
- d. 9/15h Sign Posts either side of the road at Llwynceilyn Farm Yard – It was noted that Cllr. Meirion Jones had Met with John Mc Evoy. The request has been placed on the CCC list for signs. It was noted that the farm Owner has asked that the sat nav co-ordinates for the area be redirected. Mr. McEvoy is to follow this up.
- e. 49/16/sign leading to Brynberllan through Maes yr Haidd – It was noted that the No through Road sign had been taken down as the Welsh spelling was incorrect. It has been agreed that the sign is to be replaced. It was requested that the clerk contact CCC regarding the possibility of “no Sat Nav “signage
- f. 49/16/g Pavement request from Speit Chapel to Bronsannan – It was noted that the road from Speit Chapel down towards the village has eroded and poses a health and safety risk to members of the public.

- g. 49/16/h it was noted that it is important that the local footbridges are checked & maintained on a regular basis. Councillors have been looking at local footbridges and the following require attention.
Fynnonwen and Pistyll Bach, Minyrafon and Cartref.
Glansannan Ford Bridge is in need for restorations and Street scene will carry out the work
- h. 49/16/k Hilary Coole - Missing direction sign – Old Farmers Arms, Llanfynydd.
Following a recent site meeting all parties agreed that the sign post (and direction sign plates) could be re-located. The owner of the Old Farmers Arms was satisfied with this decision
- i. 91/16/b the green road between Maesyraidd and Brynberllan near the river is now inaccessible for Walkers and vehicles. As a local resident was present at the meeting they agreed to discuss with CCC when contact is made.
- j. Concerns were raised by Councillors following the recent hedge cutting, which has caused damage to hedges and verges.
- k. Dyffryn Uchaf Carmarthenshire County Council hereby gives notice that from Monday 27th June, 2016, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along that length of road known as C2052 Llanfynydd, from a point 1 ¼ mile north-east of its junction with the C2056 for a total distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.
