**Minutes of the meeting of Llanfynydd Community Council held at 7.30pm on Tuesday,
8th of May 2018 at Speit Chapel vestry.**

170 /17: Chairman's welcome – The Chairman welcomed all present to the May meeting.

171/17: Declarations of personal interest

None were made at this point.

172/17: Contributions from the public. No members of the public were in attendance; however, Councillors took the opportunity to thank residents for the upkeep of the flowerbeds within the village.

173/17: Community Police update: PCSO Roger Anthony gave an update on local crime, it was reassuring to hear that there had not been any reported crime in the Parish during the past month. A Rural Crime Unit has been set up to coordinate reported incidents, which will assist in information handling.

Councillors reported incidents of horses coming from the common land on to nearby farms, because an access gate to the common is occasionally left open.

- 1) 167/17/2 Damage to the War memorial pillar, Councillors agreed to carry out repair work to the pillar.

177 /17: Hall Plot

- 1) The electrical pillar has been installed by Councillor members, the Chairman thanked all involved for their readiness to complete the work on behalf of the Community. Councillors will attend in due course to clear the rubble. A cheque was prepared for Western Power who will contact the clerk prior to any work commencing.
- 2) A Risk assessment has been completed for the Hall Plot as requested by Zurich Insurance. Clerk to keep a copy
- 3) It was agreed that two benches are removed, as they are in a poor condition .
- 4) The possibility of installing a garden shed to store items was discussed and will be further discussed in the future.
- 5) A discussion took place regarding regular grass cutting, and Councillors agree to put the offer out to tender. for the grass to be cut and removed 10 times in a full year.

178 /17: ROAD MAINTENANCE

Representatives of CCC Stuart Quick and Sion Lewis have agreed to attend for a further site visit on Tuesday 15th of May, Meirion Jones will attend on behalf of the Community Council.

Below is a list of already reported issues.

- 1) 91/16/b the green road between Maesyrrhaidd and Brynberllan near the river is now inaccessible for Walkers and vehicles. CCC have now agreed that this should be classified as a Through Route. Clerk to discuss with CCC
- 2) Subsidence near Brisgen Isaf on the U4431.
- 3) Potholes between Llwyn celyn and Pantyrefail U4433 clerk to chase CCC
- 4) Lllys y nant, uneven road surface. Clerk to chase CCC
- 5) The area around Brynberllan needs attention, with issues with potholes, stones on the road, and ditches needing clearing. Clerk to contact CCC
- 6) There is silt building up on the road on the bridge near the sewage works. Clerk to contact CCC
- 7) It was requested that the Road sweepers attends the area, around Clawdd Owen Clerk to contact CCC
- 8) Potholes appearing on the Llanfynydd to Abergorlech road near Pantgwyrdd.
- 9) 90/17 Request for pavement from Capel Speit to Bronsannan. We are still waiting for a copy of the original plans, which would show the boundaries of these properties. It was agreed by Councillors that this becomes an agenda item
- 10) Near Esgairgynddu a BT pole has been placed directly into a storm drain, damaging the drain. Clerk to contact CCC
- 11) Potholes appearing on Cemetery Road, near the sewage works. Clerk to contact CCC
- 12) Concerns have been raised with the volume of water running on the road around Rock House, Llanfynydd and Meadow View and the impact on the highway when icy
- 13) 16/b: Potholes at Bryn yr Eglwys – the Forestry Commission has filled some of these potholes. On Completion of their prolonged use of this section of road an inspection will take place and any remedial work completed by the Forestry Commission.
- 14) 172/16/1 Pot Holes at Abersannan on U4007 Clerk to contact CCC
- 15) 172/16/2 Subsidence along Heol Newydd clerk to contact CCC
- 16) 176/16/4 Request for road signage at Penlan Home farm as children gather there for transport to school. This has been raised previously CC Charles will discuss with CCC.
- 17) 10/7/2 Reports of subsidence between Crachty and Pantarfon, due to forestry traffic. Clerk to contact CCC
- 18) 10/17/3/ there has been damage to the Capel Isaac road sign on the bridge near to the Church clerk to contact CCC
- 19) 17/11 Road surface becoming poor near to Llwynfedwen turn clerk to contact CCC
- 20) 144/17/1 The Crash Barrier below Pantydderwen Farm has been hit, and the road seems to be subsiding around this area. Clerk to report to CCC
