019/18: Chair's welcome – Sarah welcomed all present to the July meeting.

020/18 Website: Lyndsey gave further information regarding the new website, and following a detailed discussion Councillors agreed to enter into the Council Contract with WeDig Media, which will be reviewed at the end of March 2019. Hopefully Lyndsey will return to the September meeting to show the basics of the new website, however as an invoice had not been presented, Councillors were not prepared to release the cheque. It was requested that photographs of the village were made available along with each village group getting ready to update their contents. Concerns were raised regarding the Business Directory, but Councillors were happy to run with the site until it's review date.

- 1) Notification has been received that Western Power have had to apply for a way leave from an adjoining property. Claire has agreed to discuss with Western Power

026/18: ROAD MAINTENANCE

1) It was agreed to discuss alternative sources of funding from CCC, as the Safe routes within the Community has to be supported by a local school.

Below is a list of already reported issues.

- 1) 91/16/b the green road between Maesyrrhaidd and Brynberllan near the river is now inaccessible for Walkers and vehicles. CCC has now agreed that this should be classified as a Through Route. No updates
- 2) Subsidence near Brisgen Isaf on the U4431. No updates
- 3) Potholes between Llwyn celyn and Pantyrefail U4433 No updates
- 4) Subsidence near Brisgen Isaf on the U4431. No updates
- 5) The area around Brynberllan needs attention, with issues with potholes, stones on the road, and ditches needing clearing. Work Completed
- 6) Potholes appearing on the Llanfynydd to Abergorlech road near Pantgwyrd. No updates
- 7) 90/17 Request for pavement from Capel Speit to Bronsannan. We are still waiting for a copy of the original plans, which would show the boundaries of these properties. It was agreed by Councillors that this becomes an agenda item No updates
- 8) Near Esgairgynddu, a BT pole has been placed directly into a storm drain, damaging the drain. No updates
- 9) Potholes appearing on Cemetery Road, near the sewage works. No updates
- 10) Concerns have been raised with the volume of water running on the road around Rock House, Llanfynydd and Meadow View and the impact on the highway when icy
- 11) 16/b: Potholes at Bryn yr Eglwys – the Forestry Commission has filled some of these potholes. On completion of their prolonged use of this section of road, an inspection will take place and any remedial work completed by the Forestry Commission. Work Completed
- 12) 72/16/1 Pot Holes at Abersannan on U4007 No updates
- 13) 172/16/2 Depressions along Heol Newydd No updates
- 14) 176/16/4 Request for road signage at Penlan Home farm as children gather there for transport to school. This has been raised previously CC Charles will discuss with CCC
- 15) 10/7/2 Reports of depressions in the road surface near Crachty, due to forestry traffic. No updates
- 16) 10/17/3/ there has been damage to the Capel Isaac road sign on the bridge near to the Church No updates
- 17) 144/17/1 The Crash Barrier below Pantydderwen Farm is rotten and needs replacing, and the road seems to be subsiding around this area. No updates
- 18) 160/17/1 the post and rail below Llwyncelyn Farm on the U4031 has been damaged. No updates
- 19) 167/17/2 Damage to the War memorial pillar, Councillors agreed to carry out repair work to the pillar
- 20) 009/18/1 Following road repairs along Clawdd Owen Hill Councillors were disappointed to note that the Bridge wall footings have been damaged along with damage to the actual wall. No updates
- 21) 009/18/2 A section of road near to Tiryfan ddu requires attention No updates
- 22) 009/18/3 Overhanging branches near to Brisgen need cutting back. No updates
