New issues reported.

- 1) A general request has been made for ditches to be cleared within the Parish, this would hopefully remove standing water on the roads, and help reduce the forming of potholes.
- 2) Salt boxes need filling within the Parish.
- 3) Letter of complaint received regarding the state of the highway leading to Yr Allt.

Below is a list of already reported issues.

- 1) Subsidence near Brisgen Isaf on the U4431. Reply received Deteriorated Carriageway Surface Recorded during Routine Inspections To Be Patched When Labour and Budget Allow.
- 2) Potholes between Llwyn celyn and Pantyrefail U4433 reply received Potholes Previously Filled Highway Inspector / Mobile Crew to Monitor Further and Potholes to Be Filled as and When Required.
 - 3) 72/16/1 Potholes at Abersannan on U4007 reply received Potholes previously filled further permanent patching required when budget / labour is Available. The road near Abersannan has deteriorated however only being is partially resurfaced.
