New issues reported.

1) There are flooding issues ar Abergorlech Bridge, as there is water raising around the BT post.

- 2) Potholes between Llwyn celyn and Pantyrefail U4433 reply received Potholes Previously Filled Highway Inspector / Mobile Crew to Monitor Further and Potholes to Be Filled as and When Required.
 - 3) 72/16/1 Potholes at Abersannan on U4007 reply received Potholes previously filled further permanent patching required when budget / labour is Available. The road near Abersannan has deteriorated however only being is partially resurface.
