Community of Llanfynydd Action Plan.

Annual Actions

Environment

- Implement a river watch / clean up scheme to raise awareness of pollution problems, including dumping of rubbish and knotweed.
- Encourage and involve residents in the process of general litter clearance.
- Improve the general condition of the Public Footpaths in the Community.
- Improve sign posting of the Public Footpaths

Highways

- Alert the Highways Authority to concerns over blind bends and speeding issues.
- Liaise with the Highways authority concerning the introduction of lower speed limits and traffic calming measures for vehicles, in the village
- Lobby the Highways Authority about the needs to resurface and widen some roads, provide more passing places, and maintain verges and hedges.
- Lobby the Highways Authority about the need to extend pavements within Llanfynydd.

Information / Communication

- Improve local information sharing .
- Encourage local people to contribute records and photographs to the collated to produce record of the past, and encourage local people to record their memories and experiences.
- Advertise visitor activities in conjunction with local B & B's and Guest houses e.g. walking / rambling, Nature study, fishing, photography and painting

Utilities and Services

- Liaise with the Police to ensure a greater Police presence and combat rural crime.
- Liaise with BT to bring high speed broad band to the Community

Medium Term

- Consider grants / or raising funds to provide / improve a central meeting place for community activities, organisations and groups.
- Consider applying for grants to raise funds to provide/ improve the children's playground facilities within the Community
- Seek to improve the provision of facilities for all age groups in the Community
- Support and encourage groups to organize an increased number of social events, and consider organising our own events if there are gaps.

On going

- Liaise with the Planning Authority with the regard to the nature, scale and location of any proposed housing developments within the Community.
- Encourage recycling within the Community
- Consider applying for grants to provide benches, flowerbeds and litter bins in the Community
- Monitor any proposed tourism developments to ensure they are suitable to the locality and encourage appropriate ventures.
- Seek to maintain the character and appearance of the village.
- Encourage people to preserve and maintain established natural features, especially trees and hedgerows.
- Maintain pressure and continually review actions regarding the upkeep of Highways.
- Support the status and use of the Welsh Language in the everyday life of the villages within the Community. Encourage and support those wishing to learn and help achieve the Welsh Government target of 1 million Welsh speakers by 2050
- Support wellbeing within the Community and seek to improve the provision of facilities and services.
- Review the Action Plan every 2 years. next due to be revised during 2023.
