#### 201/21: Hall Plot -

Councillor Sarah Thomas as placed the anti-slip safety strips within the gazebo. Councillors thanked her for her prompt actions, and Councillors have been in attendance weeding and clearing. The grass has been cut once during April, but it was requested that for May some grass is left to grow long, then cut prior to the Jubilee events. Councillors were in agreement for the summer planting to take place.

## 202/21: Maintenance within the Community -

1) Councillor Dai Jones volunteered to clean all the road signs leading to the village, and asses if any need replacing.
