183/22/1 – a site meeting took place with CCC on Wednesday 20th of September, regarding the need for a replacement light outside the Old Farmers Arms. It was agreed that a light will be fitted on the gable end. 27/23 – A working party needs to be organized to complete some weeding at Parc Ellie.

29/23/2 - Mud on the road around Pant Glas Farm is regularly reported.

- 1) Paths needs weeding, working Party to clear weeds.
- 2) The grass has been cut and the weeds cut back.
- A Further quote been received for the replacement for fence panels. It was agreed that the panels to be replaced would be on the Right, back and around the raised beds. Not the left side as they could be damaged if the property on that side was sold, and the new owner decided to make improvements. This side could be panelled at a later date.

- 1) The Capel Isaac Road sign at the Bridge has been damaged and has fallen off.
- 2) The issue of overhanging tree growth at Haulfryn was discussed Cllr Meirion Jones agreed to contact the landowner.

Previously reported Issues:

121/20/2 - Large potholes forming in the Clawddowen / Cefn Brisken area due to large vehicle usage. Reply from CCC – some potholes have been treated. – The area from Cefn Brisken to Blaencwm (SA32 7UH) now needs repair work.

53/21/5 - The road from Maes Ifan towards Pant Dderwen is in a poor state, and the safety barriers need replacing. An assessment has been undertaken by the design team and this section of road does not meet the current qualification standard for a vehicle restraint system. The sections of barrier lying flat on the verge have been removed.

203/21/1 - Request for further foot path improvements from Brynberllan to Sannan Garage Footpath 40/10 – Clerk was asked to contact CCC to discuss the possibility of two posts placed, one at the top and one at the bottom to prevent Quad bikes using the area. reply read Footpath

50/22/2 - Over hanging branches at Felingwm, below Llwyncelyn. – clerk to chase again

50/22/3 - Around Brisken square the width of the hedge is causing issues for traffic.

113/22/1 - It was requested that the road surface was repainted at the road junction leading from Llanfynydd towards Abergorlech.

166/22/1 - The road from Abergorlech to Llwyncelyn – Further tarmac has been laid to make the bends easier to negotiate.

166/22/4 - Potholes are forming on the highway from Penybanc and BeiliBedw towards the bridge. 202/22/1- The road from the Old School towards Pany Mawr is becoming unsafe for larger vehicles.

Major Improvements are to take place on this road to commence from October 2023 202/22/3 A BT pole between Beili Bedw and Penybanc was reported as leaning - possible safety issue
